We are happy to release the 2009-2010 Spring Allocation budget for the ASUC. There was much time and deliberation put into this process, and we hope our thoughtfulness and effort is reflected in the decisions made. The ASUC is a mere microcosm of events that occur on both a statewide and national level. As a result, the current economic recession that is facing our nation has also been reflected in the financial situation of the ASUC. For the first time in recent memory, the university is not expecting an increase in student registration, meaning the ASUC will not be expecting an increase in the money we generally allocate. Unfortunately, this means that student groups will have to face a 2% cut in allocations order for the ASUC to remain fiscally sustainable. After the 2% decrease, we allocated any surplus as fairly as possible to the student organizations. We have outlined an appeals process for the groups that feel that they need an increase in allocation, bearing in mind the financial situation that our ASUC faces.
